

Villa KuraKura is owned by four people from Buckfastleigh, Devon in the U.K. They bought the adjoining plot next to Villa Rembulan during 2008 and started building in 2010; the villa was finished about 18 months later.

Nestled in a small coconut grove just metres from the warm waters of the Indian Ocean, Villa KuraKura is built in a tropical style with the convenience of modern living. Set back from the sea, across the single track coastal road to Bangko Bangko Beach, the Villa offers a feel of the 'real' Lombok. The villa has a huge first floor decking area with doors to the living room and master bedroom, providing an open plan layout. The deck is the perfect place to enjoy al fresco dining, to take advantage of the magnificent views of the offshore islands, or to watch the friendly locals going about their business. 
